Abstracts accepted and registered to the Conference will be published in the online Proceedings of the Conference at ma.cfuv.ru

Forms of participation:

- Active Participation (abstract submission + oral presentation);
- Active Participation (abstract submission + poster presentation);
- Listener (only abstract submission).

To participate in the Conference departments submit archives (one department - one archive entitled by the name of the Department). Archives should be submitted via e-mail sno.ma.cfu@gmail.com. The archives should include:

- Scanned copy of the application form signed by the head of the department (see Annex 1).
- Individual application forms entitled by the name of the author with the abstract and authors' details (see Annex 2) submitted as a Word document (.doc file type).

The general Conference policy requires that authors should only submit original work that neither has appeared elsewhere for publication, nor is under review for another publication or conference. Literature reviews are not accepted.

Students and young scientists under the age of 35 (PhD) and under the age of 40 (doctorate degree) and pre-university students are eligible to register for the Conference.

Please note each active participant may appear as presenting author (including co-authorship) on a maximum of 2 abstracts (for oral OR poster presentation). There is no limit to the amount of abstracts one person may submit.

There are a maximum of 15 oral and 10 poster presentations per department.

Applications and abstracts that do not meet formatting requirements and received after the deadline will not be considered. All abstracts are screened for plagiarism and, when identified, the abstract and any other abstracts submitted by the same author are

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

Please read the submission rules before submitting an abstract.

Author names should appear with ***bold italic*** formatting, next line – abstract title in **BOLD UPPER CASE**, next line – affiliation details: department *in italic*, next line – academic title, surname and initials of the supervisor. Leave a line gap and begin the main text.

Abstract layout: abstracts must be submitted with the following sections: Background; Aim; Objectives; Methods; Results; Conclusions (**please see Annex 2**).

The body of the abstract should be single-spaced in 12-point Times New Roman with the page margins set 2.0 cm all round and full-width alignment. Set a paragraph indent of 1 cm. Abstracts are limited to not less than 5000 and not more than 9000 symbols in total (including spaces and punctuation). There should be no page numbers.

Clinical research acronyms and abbreviations, including organization names should be deciphered. Metric units of measurement must be separated with non-breaking spaces «Ctrl-Shift-space». To write an equation or formula use equation editor only (for example, Math Type).

When two initials and a last name are in text, it is preferred that the entire name be on one line. No tables and images, no underline or footnotes and no hyphens are allowed. A space should be inserted between the initials.

At the end of abstract the **authors' details** should be provided.

Proofread abstracts carefully to avoid errors before submission, check spelling and grammar. The abstract will be reviewed and published (if accepted) as it has been submitted – no exceptions. The organizers reserve the right to decline submissions, which fail to fit within the scope of the conference. Abstracts must be received by the announced deadline.

We ask all participants to get acquainted with the **Regulations of the Conference**, where detailed requirements for participation and evaluation criteria for presentations are stated.

Oral and poster presentations should meet the requirements specified in **points 9.8 and 9.9 of the Regulations**.
